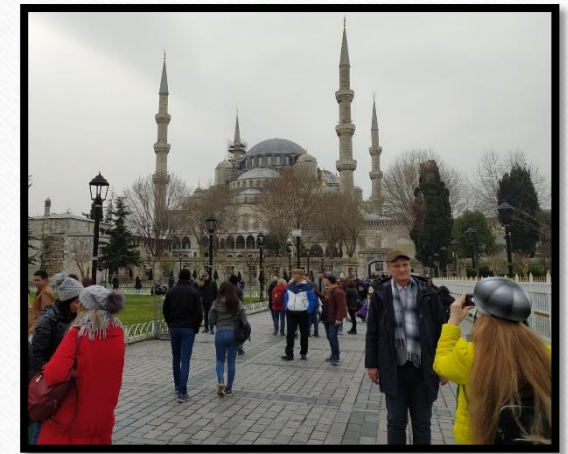
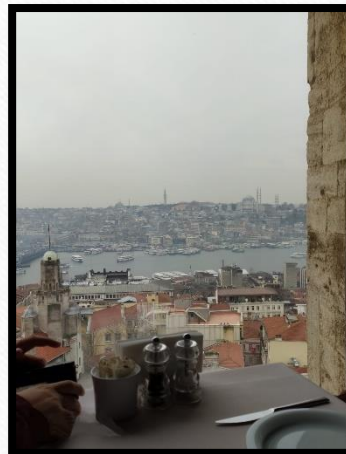
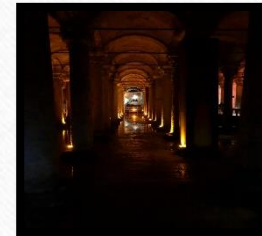
Day 1:

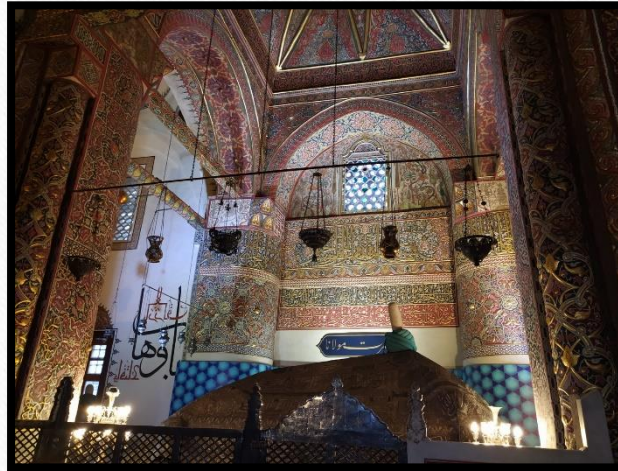
Day 2:

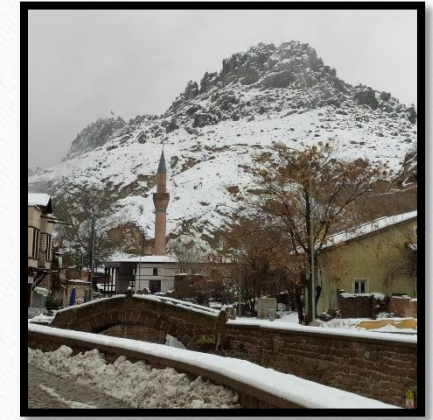
Day 3:

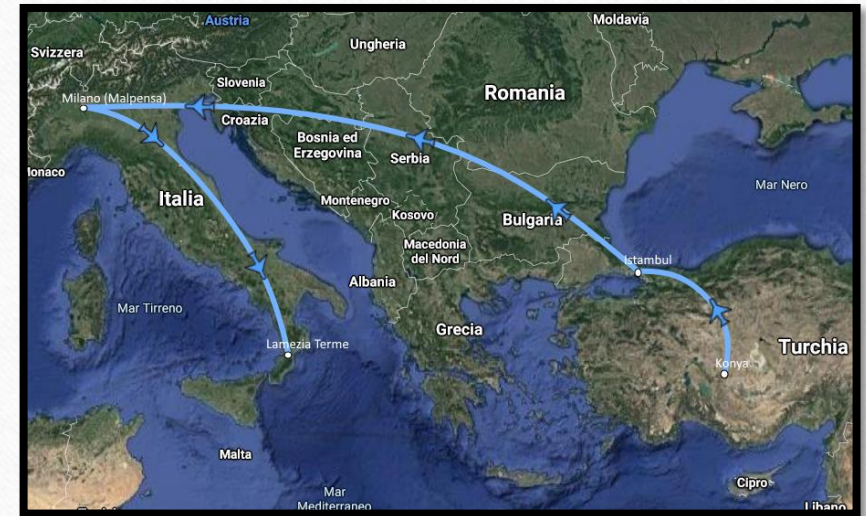
Day 7:
