Erasmus+ Orchestra



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Cultural Diplomacy: Music has often acted as a tool for cultural diplomacy, facilitating dialogue among nations and promoting peace. Concert and cultural exchanges can strengthen international relationships and promote mutual understandings.

Messages of Unity: Many European musical compositions convey messages of unity and solidarity. Beethoven's "Ode to Joy", for example, is the official anthem of the European Union and symbolizes brotherhood and hope.

The Erasmus Orchestra (EO): it is the first orchestra composed of Erasmus students from European Conservatoires and Music Institutes who are either currently participating in or have completed an Erasmus+ mobility experience. Founded in 2017 by the Erasmus+ Italian National Agency INDIRE to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the Erasmus+ Programme. Supported since 2023 by the Association Européenne des Conservatoires, Académies de Musique et Musikhochschulen (AEC), the Orchestra has further solidified its role as a flagship cultural initiative of the Erasmus+ Programme.



European Identity
