# Day 1 (7th April)

On the first day we went to the El Cid Campeador High School and the students gave us a warm welcome with an orchestra performance. After that the Spanish students presented a PowerPoint about València and prepared for us a Kahoot with questions to test our knowledge about the city. Then we discussed about what does Europe brings us, the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats, and we illustrated our works about how Basic Skills foster Erasmus priorities. From there on, the students gave us a tour of the school premises, and we visited some of the morning classes and introduced ourselves. The final activity was an interview between us Italian and Spanish students, so we could get to know each other better.



# Day 2 (8th April)

On the second day, we first presented our PowerPoint about how European union programmes favour inclusion. Then we had a river excursion, and we visited the Ciutat de les Arts, following the visit of the historical Gardens of Vivers. After that we visited the Oceanographic Museum, where we saw many species of marine animals, such as penguins, sharks, different kinds of fishes and jellyfishes, and we got to watch the dolphins' performance.



# Day 3 (9th April)

On the third day we visited the parc natural of València and the lake, La Albufera. We saw different kinds of birds and ducks, then we had lunch together in El Palmar, a small town near the lake. After lunch we had a boat trip in the La Albufera Lake, with a guide explaining us the history of the lake and its ecosystem.



# Day 4 (10th April)

On the fourth day, after our presentation about we went to school and read our presentation about digital skills and how they are the key to the future. Afterwards we had a city tour and visited the Mercat Central de València, The Llotja and Redona square, with the Spanish students explaining the history of the city. At the end we walked through the old part of València, where the Muslim community lives.



# Day 5 (11th April)

On the fifth and last day, we first went to school and read the presentation about music for European alliances. After that we did our last tasks and then we had the certificate ceremony and the final greetings to the school in the Roman theatre. In the evening, we had our farewell dinner at school, and we ate the traditional paella from València.... which was delicious.
